**M**ust be at least 18 years of age, and must pass a post-offer drug screen and physical. Processors must be able to stand and work for long hours in an often wet and cold environment. Shifts will vary depending on fish, and processors must be prepared to work seven days a week for up to 18 hours per day. There may also be periods of time when there are few or no hours of work. Must be able to repeatedly lift up to 50 pounds. Must have a basic understanding of English, including the ability to follow written or oral instructions. Must be able to climb stairs, and stand and walk on uneven and slippery surfaces. Must be willing to work any shift, including nights. Processing employees must be able to walk quickly to designated areas in the event of an emergency and must be able to follow emergency instructions. All WSI employees must be willing to work and live in a multi-cultural environment.
