ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Various positions will be open this season and might vary from transferring salmon from the beach and fishing vessels (tenders) at our dock to the processing facilities on shore. Beach Gang positions also constructs, maintains, and repairs the facility's docks, loads/unloads freight, and provides support for the fleet.

- Transfer salmon from various fishing vessels to our processing facilities on shore.
- Maintain, repair and construct docks
- Load and unload freight for fishing vessels
- Provide support for fisherman including handling and storing of fishing equipment
- Use vertical ladders and elevated walkways
- Work on barges, ship decks, and inside fish holds
- Work as a team in a multicultural environment
- Outdoor working conditions include rain, snow, wind, hot and cold temperatures
