- Assist fleet manager with fishing and tendering operations in Egegik

- Help communicate fishery and company information to fishermen and tendermen through all available means (radio, in person, email/text)

- Manage fishermen and tender parts ordering, ensuring correct parts are ordered and delivered to the correct location in a timely fashion.
