EXPERIENCE GAINED: RACEJT offers a comprehensive education with 20+ certifications and classes, and experience in leadership, teamwork, computer software, and job readiness skills. Graduates receive a RACEJT diploma and are qualified for many job positions, including Waste collector, Landfill operator, Contaminated site worker, Tank inspector, Brownfield technician, Recycling Center Manager, and many others.

COLLEGE CREDIT: Earn 10 University of Alaska college credits and an Occupational Endorsement as a Rural Waste Management & Spill Response Technician.

RETENTION & PLACEMENT: RACEJT has an 84% retention rate and 98% job placement rate. Job search and retention skills are taught, and placement assistance is provided.

ELIGIBILITY: RACEJT is open to under employed rural Alaska residents. Our goal is to place graduates in a local job position that helps to protect community environmental health. Applicants with strong potential to secure local or regional employment will receive priority program acceptance.
