Electrical Wiring is a 40-hour introductory training which covers the basics of electrical theory, electrical code, blueprints, and tool safety. Handson training includes wiring of switches, GFCI receptacles, duplex receptacles, panels, 3-way and 4-way switches and bending EMT. At the end of the week, students apply the skills they learned by individually assembling and wiring a lamp with light switch, outlets, and USB receptacles.
